Riverside County to debut County Circle Farmers Market

Building on the success of thriving Farmers Markets at the County Administration offices in downtown Riverside and at Riverside University Health System – Medical Center in Moreno Valley, the County of Riverside is set to host its third open-air market at the Health Administration Building (HAB) in Riverside.

The County Circle Farmers Market soft launch is planned from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Thursday, November 30 at the HAB, located at 4065 County Circle Drive in Riverside.

“We are so pleased to see how the Farmers Markets initiative has been embraced by Riverside County residents and staff.
